Why learn makeup at all?

In many areas, the makeup artistry industry isn't regulated. This means that anyone can pick up a brush, watch a few YouTube videos and call themselves a "makeup artist".

That's why it's so important to get a solid makeup education. When you can demonstrate that you're a certified makeup artist, it sends a clear message to clients and employers. A makeup certification will prove that:

- 1. You have been evaluated and critiqued by an industry expert
- 2. You have a strong knowledge of current makeup techniques
- 3. You understand the hygiene and safety guidelines that will keep clients out of harm's way

At the end of the day, most clients will judge your skills based on your portfolio. A certification will make them feel more at-ease that you know what you're doing and they won't leave your studio with a skin infection or worse!

How makeup training works

There are hundreds of makeup schools you could attend, and thousands of different training programs. For a well-rounded education, there are usually three parts to a makeup artistry training program.

Makeup Theory

The theory portion of a makeup artistry program gives you the fundamentals you'll need to be a good makeup artist, before you ever pick up a brush.

In these units, you learn everything from the history of makeup to proper hygiene practices to color theory and identifying face shapes and skin tones. All these elements are crucial to any serious professional makeup artist.

Technique Development

This is where you're going to start learning the building blocks of a good makeup artist. You'll learn techniques such as color-matching, contouring, blending, tightlining, and more. You'll practice each technique one at a time so that your tutor or instructor can evaluate your work and help you improve.

Once you have the building blocks, you're ready to start putting together complete makeup looks.

Complete Makeup Application

Now that you have a solid foundation in makeup theory and technique, it's time to put your skills to the test and start creating full makeup looks on models. This is the fun part!

During this stage of your makeup training, you'll be asked to create a number of full makeup applications on different clients. Odds are you won't only be graded by your instructor, but also by the model you worked on.

Remember, being a good makeup artist is about more than just practical skills. It's also about working with people!

Is online learning right for me?


Because of the lack of structure in an online learning environment, students need to be self-disciplined and motivated in order to complete the course work.
